 dummy load. 46 watts power is being put out to the antenna with a max of 3 watts
 reflected. The antenna and duplexers were replaced in 2018 and the PA about 20 years
 ago (2003?)
- Mike pulled out his old DR1x and it still works. Hope to swap it with the 147.120 repeater. John to come along.

New Business:
