Nothing definitive determined at this time.
 - Discussion was had about 146.625 repeater and 147.12. Matthew says ARES is going to do signal reports and tests between the two with thoughts of moving the ARES activations and nets to the 146.625. There was discussion about letting the 147.12 frequency pair being released.
